5. Multi-wheeled track (pump track) on the Mitre Field

Councillor McArdle gave an overview of the proposed plan for a recreation space for the children of the Parish. A multi-wheeled track (pump track) to be sited on Mitre Field, which is held in trust for the children of the Parish. The Parish Council wished to assess the public's view on this proposal. Views were given by attendees. Concerns over the noise, access and possible unruly behaviour were heard. The Council and some parents of local children that attended, advised that they did not think that these would be issues and welcomed the idea to have some dedicated facility for children to use. The Parish Council will continue investigations into the proposed plan and the public will be kept informed via Council meeting minutes, Council website and the Parish magazine.

A member of the public advised that an up to date calendar of jubilee events will be shared in the parish magazine.
